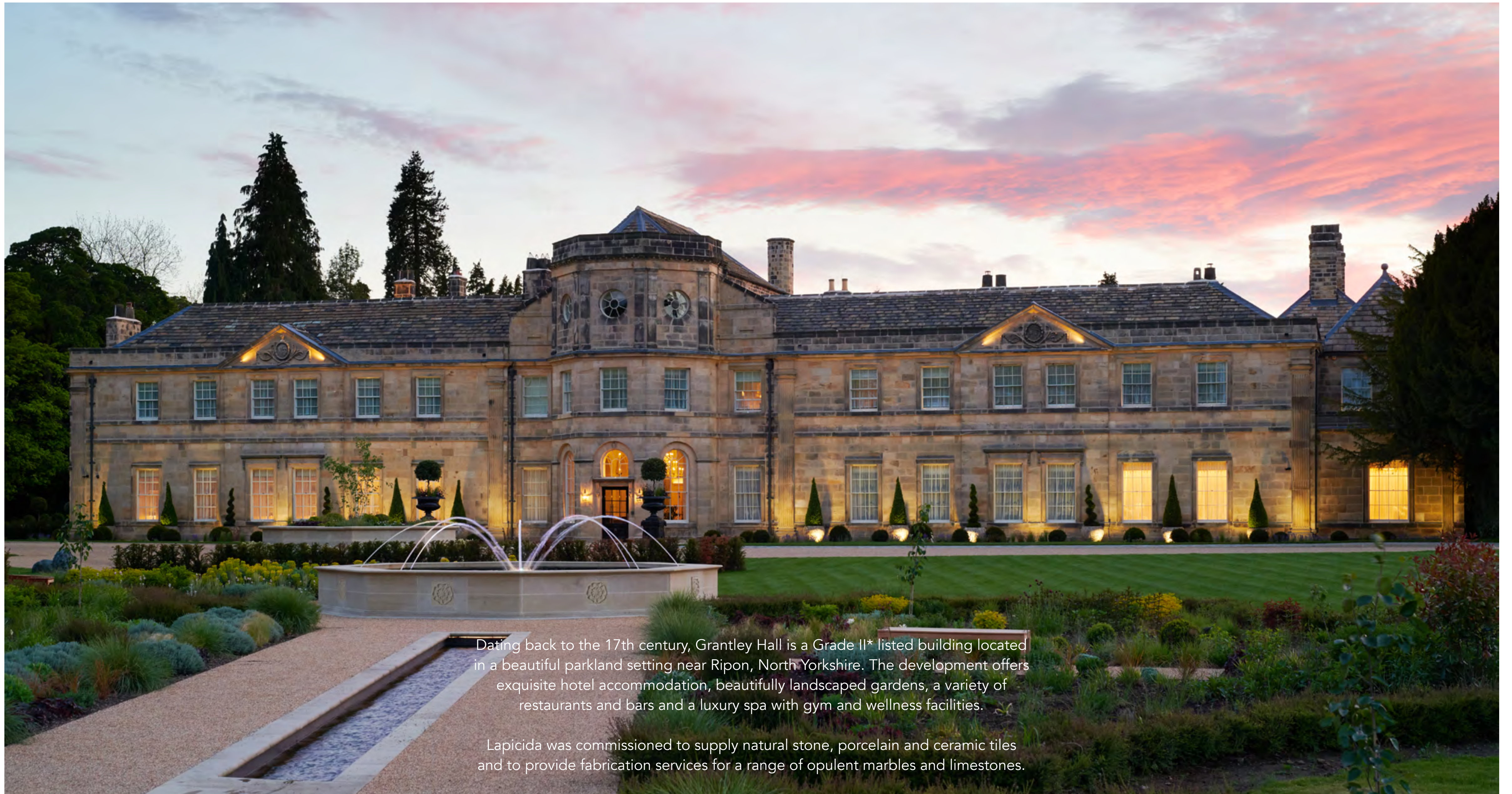

Dating back to the 17th century, Grantley Hall is a Grade II* listed building located in a beautiful parkland setting near Ripon, North Yorkshire. The development offers exquisite hotel accommodation, beautifully landscaped gardens, a variety of restaurants and bars and a luxury spa with gym and wellness facilities.

Lapicida was commissioned to supply natural stone, porcelain and ceramic tiles and to provide fabrication services for a range of opulent marbles and limestones.

IN THE DETAIL

Embracing advances in technology, our range of porcelain and ceramic surfaces offers boundless variation in colour, tone and detail with unmatched resilience. The products are often designed to mimic their natural stone counterparts with detailing that would challenge a seasoned eye.

Biblical Grey Gold, a beautiful hand-distressed limestone, adds texture to the walls of the glazed atrium area.



Elegant San Marino marble adorns the hotel's 47 en-suite bathrooms. A range of approaches from geometric stone floors, etched panels and intricately cut vanity tops and shower bases are present throughout the space.

Verde Guatemala embellishes the bar frontage and furniture pieces throughout the hotel. The marble fabricated for the table tops has been acid washed to prevent alcohol etching the face of the surface and pre-sealed to prevent staining.

FORM & FUNCTION

The wellness philosophy behind the Three Graces Spa is based on balance which we mirrored in our supply and fabrication of St Tropez limestone flooring for the spa and changing rooms. In the wet areas, the limestone has been sandblasted for slip resistance. As a result, the limestone is slightly lighter in tone.

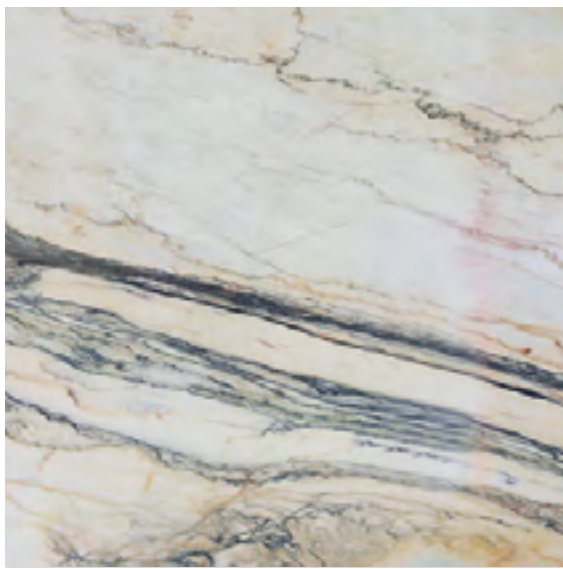

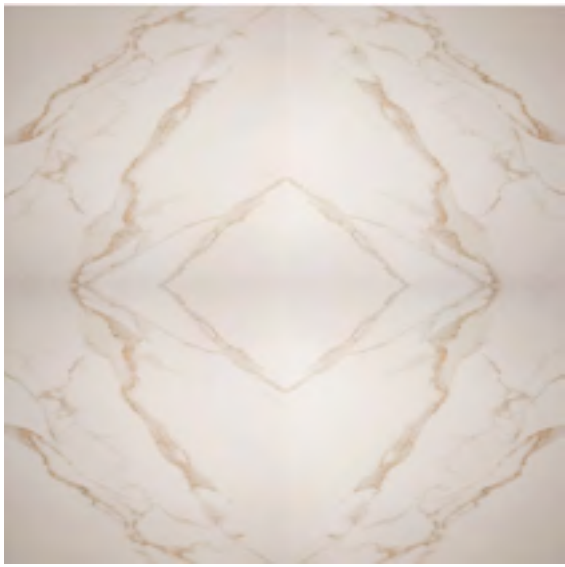

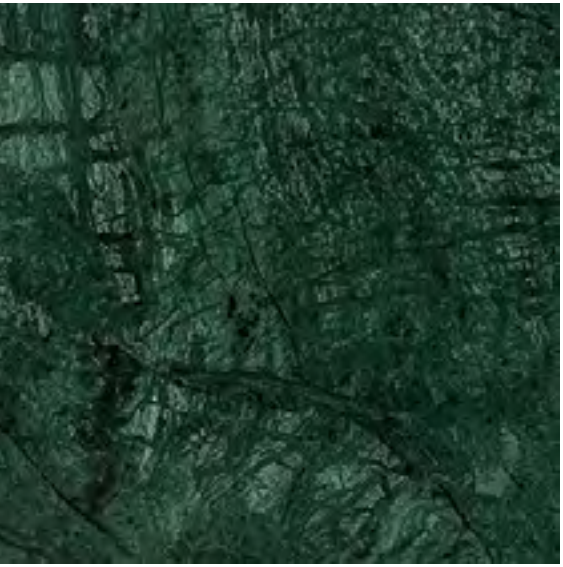
